This Indenture made the 12th day of August in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and forty three, Between Benjamin Whitfield of the first
part Wm. Whitfield Trustee of the second part and Nancy Brett of the third
part: all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia: Whereas some
Brett is in imminent circumstances and he begs the daughter of said Benjamin
Whitfield is lately in suffer for the maintenance of life and her Father having recently
conceive to desire to be settled for her sole Benefit some property

Now this Indenture witnesseth: That for and in Consideration of the natural
love and affection which said Benjamin Whitfield bears to his said daughter, and
the wife of James Brett as well as the further Consideration of one dollar to him in
hand paid by the said Wm. Whitfield Trustee before the sealing and delivery of the
premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged: the said Benjamin Whitfield
has given granted sold and conveyed and by these presents doth give grant sell and
convey unto him the said Wm. Whitfield Trustee his heirs and assigns from the
following property (to wit) one feather Bed Bed sheet and furnished on that
one looking glass and two trunks: To have and to hold the said property to have
the said Wm. Whitfield Trustee and his heirs forever: Upon trust notwithstanding for
the following purposes that is to say: that the said Wm. Whitfield Trustee shall
hold the said property for the sole and separate use of Nancy Brett wife of James
Brett and permit her to enjoy the same free from the claims and demands and
Control of said James Brett and to be in the way or manner subject to any will or
conveyance which the said James Brett may make or which the Mary daughter of
said James Brett shall make: And at the death of said James Brett the said Wm. Whitfield Trustee shall
in witness whereof the said Benjamin Whitfield and Wm. Whitfield Trustee shall
