the heirs of the late George S. Gandy on the south by Kates Mill Pond & on the west
by the lands belonging to the estate of the late Morgan Hennocke: To have and to
hold the same to the said Doversy Pond his heirs and assigns forever: I the said
Amelton Densord wife Mary do covenant to the said Doversy Pond that we are
lawfully seized of said land have a good right to convey it and that the same is
unencumbered. I Amelton Densord wife Mary as further covenant and bind ourselves
our heirs and representatives to warrant and forever defend the title to the said land
and every part thereof to the said Doversy Pond his heirs and assigns against the
lawful claims of all persons whatsoever. At Hildes our hands date this 26th
