Hels of the same part and Lawrence Bells of the other part all of this County of Southampton Higginbotham that Whereas the said Higginbotham Brockhead is indebted to the said Lawrence Bells in sum of Two hundred and seventy three dollars and by Court hearing date the 22nd day of October 1843 also another Bond for the sum of Twenty dollars thirty one Cents bearing date the 25th day of September 1843 and being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof hath agreed to convey the property herein after mentioned unto the said Saml. Hels in trust to be held for the purpose: Now Therefore the said Higginbotham Brockhead as well for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Saml. Hels at or before the entering and delivery of this bond with good Bargaining and sale and as by these presents Bells and full unto the said Saml. Hels has less'd I answer the following property to wit: One bushel and Cwt. whole 20 bushels three innumar 3 Cwt. 2 bushels three innumar 3 bushels of their innumar plantation articles. Cwt. of corn fed for horses holt and kitchen furniture. To have and to hold the said property unto him the said Saml. Hels his exec's ad'm'r forever.
