Everett by all or either of the executors aforesaid previous to advertising the land and improvements hereby named at least twenty days public notice of the time and place of sale at some or most public places in the neighbourhood and sell for cash on the premises the land hereby conveyed or so much thereof as will be sufficient to pay in full and to the D^r Bryant which will be on account of that sum also the debt due to D^r Bryant which will be due the 1st April 1845 also the debt due to Pease & Peale due by this date and out of the proceeds of such sale first satisfy and pay all reasonable cost attending the said debt and pay & satisfy the two debts due to D^r Bryant as before aforesaid, and for and satisfy the debt due to the firm of Pease & Peale and lastly if a sum then remains pay the same to the said W^t L.
