eight hundred and forty three between Emma Beaton of the first part John
Beoth of the second part and Nathaniel T. Williams of the third part: whereas
the said Emma Beaton is justly indebted to the said N. T. Williams in the
sum of five hundred dollars due the 21st day of October 1843 by bond also
the said N. T. Williams is security for the said Emma Beaton to Nathaniel
Francis for the sum of four hundred fifty dollars due the 28th day of Sept 1843
which debt (with the legal interest thereon accruing) the said Emma Beaton
is willing and anxious to secure: Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one
dollar to the said Emma Beaton in hand paid by the said John Beoth at
and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said Emma Beaton hath given granted Bargained sold
conveyed enfeoffed released and Conformed and by these presents hath given granted
bargained sold alien enfeoff released and Conformed to the said John Beoth his heirs
and assigns forever: all that tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County
of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing Two hundred and forty acres
be the same more or less and bounded as follows separated by the flat swamp
from the lands of Henry Kinard & Co. to the north by the name of the lands of
John Rockwell Lawson Beath & others & known by the name of Dry Run depot
also Negro Man Mingo, four head of mules, two head of horses one negro and
hemp six feather Beds & furniture one Clock one Chest of drawers one oval
table one pair of Corn fodder press & pictures two Carts & wheels one work or thirty
head of hogs & their manure & all my household and kitchen furniture with
all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging even
any view appertaining, and all the estate right title and interest of the said
Emma Beaton in and to the said grant or interest to be hereby granted tract
of land and premises: To HAVE and to hold the said hereby granted or
interest to be hereby granted tract of land & premises with its appurtenances
together with the aforesaid slaves and all the other personal property hereby
conveyed unto the said John Beoth his heirs Executors administrators and
