

This Indenture made and entered into this twenty first day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty three between Edwin Haller of the first part William M. Everett of the second part and Nathaniel Francis of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia; witnesseth that whereas the said Edwin Haller is fully indebted to the said Nathaniel Francis in the sum of Nine hundred and twenty Nine dollars and thirty cents bearing date from time to date the 21st day of October 1843 and on demand this foreaid day and whereas the said Edwin Haller being desirous and willing to leave and does hereby give the said Nathaniel Francis in the amount aforesaid such Bargin and sell to the aforesaid William M. Everett his representative &c forever the following perfectly described hundred and thirty three acres of land lying more or less it being and lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by the lands of Robt. Riddle, Nathl. Gammie and others and also one Negro woman named Stumpy Jenny and two children Belona and Amorette to have and to hold the aforesaid land and other property to held in trust and the said Edwin Haller shall by these presents covenant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid property hereby conveyed unto him the said William M. Everett Trustee against the claim of himself and against the claim of all and every other person or persons whatsoever upon trust notwithstanding that the said William M. Everett shall suffer the said Edwin Haller to remain in quiet possession of the aforesaid property until the aforesaid Nathaniel Francis may shanty temporal government either written or oral to the said William M. Everett Trustee as aforesaid after having given lawful notice except to public auction for each the property aforesaid hereby Conveyed or to much thereof as will be sufficient to pay and satisfy the debt to the aforesaid Nathaniel Francis and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay and satisfy all reasonable cost attending the removing and carrying this debt into effect secondly pay and satisfy the debt to the said Nathaniel Francis as aforesaid which is hereby declared or intended to be levied: and finally if a deficiency then remains in his hands pay the same to the aforesaid Edwin Haller or to any person authorized to receive it for him: In Testimony whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written
