 Ex? this true payment thereof and also to save the said Sampson & Pates
 harmless from the above Note due to said Selwell as also one other to be
 Debtors in hand paid by Edward P. Turner the trust the receipt whereof is hereby
 to acknowledged: I the said John R. Rochelle have granted Bargained and
 J & H sold by these presents do grant Bargain sell unto the said Edward P.
 Turner all of my interest in the above Negroes of Mrs. Anna Selwell the
 A Court dated a Negro man by the name of John and a Negro woman by the name
 Record Book Lucy and her child Herod one bay horse one Cow and Cattle
 31st of the feather Bed and furniture one table and one and the whole of my
 Book household and kitchen furniture: also a tract of land lying at or near
 my brother's capital supposed to be 36 acres but the same more or less
 my interest in a tract of land in the upper part of this County lying
 the lands of Samuel Bankham and others: To have the aforesaid property
 in special trust and consideration to the intent and purposes that if upon
 sum of one hundred and eighty eight dollars and 6/10c due to Reas & Pates and
 also the sum of Two hundred and twenty three dollars and 44/100 due
 Wm. J. Selwell with Sampson & Pates security shall remain unpaid to
 the said Edward P. Turner has been executor's administrator or assigns that
