This Indenture made this 30 day of October 1843 Between Comorgrines Leston R. Edwards Comorgrines under a writ of the County Court of Southampton in a suit in ch. Broadhous & Weston of the one part Williamson and James H. Williamson and Archd. Atkinson of the other part Metrefest that whereas in the said aforesaid @ cause was made on the 17th July 1843 whereby it was agreed that unto the said Matthew Weston should pay to the said the amt of his amount and costs on or before the day of sale the said Leston R. Edwards was to sell to the highest bidder the tract of land on which Dorothy Weston lives and which belongs in remainder to the said Matthew Weston for cash after having advertised the time and place of sale for 4 weeks successively the said sale to take place at the Court house of the same as in pursuance of said decree notice having been given as under the said Leston R. Edwards did expose the said land to the highest bidder for cash when James H. Williamson and Archd. Atkinson being the highest bidder purchased the said land at the price of fifty five dollars which they have paid to said Edwards therefore the said bargain for the consideration aforesaid with Bargain sell & convey the lands aforesaid that assumed or come by will from John Weston to his son Matthew Weston aforesaid in which Dorothy Weston was a life estate which lands contain by estimation 139 1/2 acres more or less on Black Creek in miles north of Court house lying the lands sold as aforesaid. To have and to hold the said lands to the said James H. Williamson and Atkinson their heirs & assigns forever from the claim of said Edwards and all claiming under him but no otherwise.
