This Indenture made and entered into this day of One thousand Eight hundred and forty three Between James Beck of the one part and John Hilliard of the other part both of the County of Southampton State of New York Whereas that Gilbert Downing Conveyed by act of Trust bearing date the 8th day of January 1842 and duly Recorded in the Clerk's office of Southampton to the aforesaid James Beck one tract of Land containing two hundred and thirty seven acres by the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit On the west by the Lanes of William Bayham: here on the North by the sound hill Swamp on the South by Stegars Lane and James Nunn's Land: To secure the payment of a certain Bond due John Beck to which the said Gilbert Downing gave to the said John Beck all of which will appear by reference to a deed on Record in the said County the said Gilbert Downing having faithfully made payment as stipulated and thereby violated his condition aforesaid in the said act of trust the said tract of Land was set up and sold to the highest Bidder for Cash the 10th day of November 1843 bearing forewarning given and Notice to the aforesaid sale: for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred fifty six dollars and Cents in hand raised by the sale of the said tract of Land the sum for which the said tract of Land was bid off by the said James Beck hath granted Bargained and sold unto John Hilliard the above named tract of Land being the same which Belonged to Gilbert Downing particularly described in the deed of Trust with all the necessary necessary remainders or remainders grante or without note of any particular and every part or parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said tract with
