This Indenture made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of Nov 1863  
Between Edward B. Island & Martha his wife of the County of Southampton  
of the first part and Albert S. Nevell of the second part testifying  
that for and in consideration of the sum Twenty five hundred Sixty  
six dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged by them the s<sup>d</sup> Edward B. Island and wife know Bargained  
and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell to the s<sup>d</sup> Albert  
S. Nevell a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the County of  
Southampton bounded as follows beginning at a lightwood post a corner bet  
Harris and s<sup>d</sup> Nevells thence s<sup>d</sup> Harris line S 9 E 117 poles to the next  
a corner of s<sup>d</sup> Island thence his line South 37 poles to a small  
pine thence S 66 E 26 poles to a red oak thence N E 14 poles  
to a pine thence S 87 E 16 poles to the end of a small branch  
thence down the run of a branch to a black gum a corner for s<sup>d</sup>  
Nevell and Evans. To Jones thence his line N 78 E 6 to the next  
thence s<sup>d</sup> road to a red oak thence s<sup>d</sup> Jones line to a maple  
a corner for s<sup>d</sup> Nevells goes in the sug<sup>s</sup> line thence s<sup>d</sup> Jones  
to a white oak on road a corner in Bungs Williamson's line thence  
s<sup>d</sup> Williamson's line to the first station containing by estimation  
about four acres he the same more or less to  
have and to hold the aforesaid land and premises with the appurtenances  
to him the said Albert S. Nevell his heirs and assigns in absolute full  
simple estate and the s<sup>d</sup> Island & wife covenant with the s<sup>d</sup> Nevell  
his heirs and assigns that he and they shall have and enjoy a good  
title to the premises with full freedom of the same in the 25<sup>th</sup> last and  
forever from the claims of all and every person whatsoever. In witness
