The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Samuel Whitelhead having Conveyed to Nathaniel Francis by Deed of Sept^{ember} certain property herein mentioned upon the Consideration that he the said Nathaniel Francis is to furnish the said Samuel Whitelhead with a decent support Clothing Medical attendance and all other necessary things during her life Now in Case the said Nathaniel Francis shall pay all necessary expenses day for Clothing Medical aid and support the said Samuel Whitelhead securely then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and witness

This Indenture made this 16th day of October in the year 1843

One thousand eight hundred and forty three between John Wicks and Mary Wicks and Mary Wicks his wife and John B. Wicks acting as Trustee for the benefit of James Wicks and James Wicks of the one part and Robert G. Griffin of the other part and all of the County of Southampton Wickspeaks: That the said John Wicks and Mary his wife John B. Wicks and James Wicks for and in Consideration of the sum of Three thousand dollars of lawful Money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Robert G. Griffin at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and let and each of with bargain and sell unto the said Robert G. Griffin his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by recent survey One thousand and Ninety three acres reserving fit of an acre for a Grange and bounded at follows: Beginning at a red oak in the South field road and running N.E. to a corner on Mary Wicks line to the corner of Peter J.
