This Indenture made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1810 between John Wick  
Trustee of Abner B. Board of the parish of St Mary and County of  
Southampton of the one part and Edwin N. Williams of the 2<sup>d</sup> part  
and County of the other part: Witnesseth that he the said John Wick  
Trustee of Abner B. Board first in consideration of the sum being two  
dollars 70 Cent Current Money of W<sup>m</sup> to him in hand P<sup>d</sup> by the said  
Edwin N. Williams at or before the making and signing of these  
premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and therefore  
agreed and released the 2<sup>d</sup> Edwin N. Williams his heirs Executors  
and assigns by these premises then the 2<sup>d</sup> John Wick Trustee of  
Abner B. Board did sell ad publicum one certain tract of Land Contain-  
ing to him by deed of trust and assignment given up in a shroque for  
the benefit of James Wick: and Edwin N. Williams became the  
purchaser & therefore Convey as trustee of D. Board the said land in the  
Deed of Trust mentioned containing by estimation one hundred acres  
lying in the County of Southampton and is bounded as follows West  
by Abner Stephensens land on the N<sup>th</sup> East by Senock Branches  
land and by search swamp on the South. & Convey as trustee of D.  
Board the D. Land houses ways Water Courses profits Commodities heretofore  
received or hereafter to be received or to be received or parcel of land  
belonging or in any way appertaining to the succession and succession business  
and remainance rents and profits thereof of every part and parcel thereof  
... and all the right title interest or claim whatsoever of him the said  
John Wick as trustee or his heirs to him the said Edwin N. Williams  
and to his heirs and assigns forever to have & to hold the 2<sup>d</sup> part  
or parcel of land with the appertanances to the same to the 2<sup>d</sup> Edwin  
N. Williams the wife and heirs of D. Board the 2<sup>d</sup> John Wick Trustee  
of Abner B. Board each agree to warrant and defend the title in them  
made to the said Edwin N. Williams and his heirs forever: In Witness
