This Indenture made this 8 day of Nov 1810 between John Vick Trustee of Abner B. Shattuck of the parish of Newbury and County of Southampton of the one part and Edwin N. Williams of the 2^d Ward and County of the other part: Witnesseth that he the said John Vick Trustee of Abner B. Shattuck first in consideration of the sum being two dollars 70 Cents Current Money of the to him in hand paid by the said Edwin N. Williams at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and therefore agreed and assigned the 2^d Edwin N. Williams his heirs Executor and assigns by these presents that the 2^d John Vick Trustee of Abner B. Shattuck did sell as publick and certain tract of land Comers to him by deed of trust and afterwards gave up in a Mortgage for the benefit of James Vick: and Edwin N. Williams became the purchaser & therefore Convey as trustee of D. Shattuck the said land in the Deed of Trust mentioned containing by estimation one hundred acres lying in the County of Southampton and is bounded as follows West by Allen Hephensons land on the N^W East by Seneca Branches land and by Search Swamp on the South. & Convey as trustee of D. Shattuck the 2^d Land houses wago Water Courses profits Commodities heretofore received or hereafter whatsoever to this 2^d Land or tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way appertaining to the revenues and avocations revenues and remainders rents and profits thereof of every part and parcel thereof and all the right title interest or claim whatsoever of him the said John Vick as trustee or his heirs to him the said Edwin N. Williams and to his heirs and assigns forever to have & to hold the 2^d Land or parcel of land with the appurtenances to the same to the 2^d Edwin N. Williams the wife and heirs of D. Shattuck the 2^d John Vick Trustee of Abner B. Shattuck each agree to warrant and defend the title in him made to the said Edwin N.
