and doth by these presents confirm and assent unto the said Geo St. Gardner his heirs heirs and assigns One Certain and
parcel of containing two hundred acres in the same more or less lying and
being in the County of Southampton on Black Creek swamp it being the part
of the Barren tract which the said Allen Edwards purchased of Wm.
Bowen and is bounded as follows viz By the run of the said Black Creek
swamp and Big Griffon tract To have and to hold the aforesaid tract
and parcel of land forever and the said Allen Edwards with hereby
warrant and will forever defend the aforesaid tract and parcel of land
