Person of the said County was bound at security by an indenture bearing date 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1842 and admitted to Record in the County Court of Southampton on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January 1842 did convey to the said James H. Person certain property particularly described in said indenture and among other property all his interest in being one third part of the land of land of which Randolph Newson died seized laying in the County aforesaid and containing from the report of Surveyor Commissioner appointed by the County Court of said County and returned to November Court 1843 £76 4/- arrear together with all rights and appurtenances therin in any manner belonging in trust Newson Sheriff and with power and authority to the said James H. Person to sell the same for the purpose of paying said debts and expenses attending said trust if the said David Newson should fail to discharge the said debts according to the time and effect thereof whenever after such default the said John A. Person should require a sale thereof to be made and whenever the said David Newson having failed to pay the said debts and the said John A. Person having in consequence thereof required a sale of said land to be made for the purpose aforesaid the said James H. Person in execution of said trust after giving the proper notice required in said indenture did on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year 1842 expose to sale at public auction to the highest bidder the said tract of land with the improvements and appurtenances and at the sale so made the said William B. Gouray became the purchaser of said land with the appurtenances to for the sum of £152-00 which was the highest bid made for the same and that sum he had tendered paid to the said James H. Person. Now This Indenture witnesseth that the said James H. Person for and in Consideration of the said sum of £152-00 which he has received from the said William B. Gouray as mentioned above hath granted bargained sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said William B. Gouray his heirs and assigns forever the said land herein before mentioned and more particularly described in the report of said Commissioner hereinfor mentioned accompanying survey together with all improvements and appurtenances therin in any manner belonging to have and to hold the said land and appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest of the said James H. Person therein unto the said William B. Gouray his heirs & assigns and the said James H. Person for himself his heirs & executors & executors' executors to and with the said William B. Gouray his heirs and assigns that he will forever warrant and defend the said land hereby conveyed with the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said William B. Gouray his heirs and assigns against the claim of the said James H. Person and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof by force or
