Butts mill Spiney and Jeffre Spiney North and North west by the horse pasturage separating the clear land from John W. Butts West's Hill and Benjamin Bowring and William Bowring and west by John Pickering Williams Morings and above Gray: To have and to hold the said tract of land and appurtenances and advantages rents fruits and profits thereof to the said lands belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Edward Butts and Archibald Atkinson their heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of the said Bowring his heirs and assigns and against all persons claiming by, from or under him in any wise whatsoever in witness whereof the said John Bowring above written made the will witnessed of the said Thomas Gray and heirels set his hand and seal the day and year first herein written.

This Indenture made and entered into on this 3<sup>d</sup> day of May year 1843 by and between John Hamond and Sally Hamond his wife holding and keeping Barnes having each party heretofore of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginie this indenture witnesseth that they the said John Hamond and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety dollars to them said Hamonds in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged they the said Hamonds have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargaine and sell unto him the above named Jacob Barnes the same and all and every part of the same lands with all appurtenances to the said land now belonging which comes to the said John Hamond of him the said Jacob Barnes some one or two years since, lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded to contain about eleven acres in the same more or less the boundaries thereof will appear by former deeds. To have and to hold the before described lot and parcel of land to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever; free from the claims of whom the said John Hamond and Sally his wife are free from the claim of any and every person or persons whomever; and they the said John Hamond and Sally his wife do also by these presents warrant and forever hereafter defend the title to said land in fee to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever.
