This Indenture made and entered into on this 3rd day of May year 1863 by and
 between John Hamard and Sally Hamard his wife feeling and Jacob Bannas having
 each party heirs of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia this indenture
 witnesses that they the said John Hamard and Sally his wife for and in Consider-
 ation of the sum of Ninety dollars to them said Hamards in hand paid by the said
 Jacob Bannas at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged they the said Hamards have bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the above named
 Jacob Bannas the same and all and every part of the same lands with all
 appurtenances to the said land now belonging whiche lands is the the said John
 Hamard of him the said Jacob Bannas some one or two years since lying in the
 aforesaid County of Southampton and supposed to contain about eleven acres the
 the same more or less the boundaries thereof will appear by former deeds: To
 have and to hold the before described lot and parcel of land to him the said
 Jacob Bannas his heirs and assigns forever: free from the claims of any and every
 said John Hamard and Sally his wife I also free from the claims of any and every
 person or persons whomsoever: and they the said John Hamard and Sally his wife
 do also by these presents warrant and forever hereafter defend the title to said
 land in fee to him the said Jacob Bannas his heirs and assigns forever In
 Witness whereof they the above named John Hamard and Sally his wife have
 hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written
