in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty three day and between  
Robert Revel of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the other part each  
of whom resides in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia  
This Instrument witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum  
of fifty dollars paid to the said Robert Revel by the above named  
Jacob Barnes and before sealing and delivering of these presents the  
full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert  
Revel has and doth hereby bargain and sell unto him the said  
Jacob Barnes a certain parcel or lot of land lying and being in the  
aforesaid County of Southampton the same being particularly the same  
land which was annexed to the said Robert Revel by Henry Revel  
and by his last will and testament which lands of said land  
had been settled by Commissioners to the different heirs of said  
deceased the aforesaid to the said Robert Revel containing about nineteen  
acres the premises number of acres of the land thus sold as aforesaid  
as well as the boundaries of the same will appear by referring to the map  
or of said Commissioners for him the said Jacob Barnes to have  
and to hold the said parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him  
the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever; with all the rights  
titles interest and estate to the said land belonging or appertaining to him  
the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever; and by this said  
Robert Revel and hereby warrant and forgive hereafter before the night of  
in and to the above described parcel of land in fee simple to him the  
said Jacob Barnes against himself his heirs and assigns and also  
against all and every person or persons whatsoever; free from all  
manners of claim or demand whatsoever of whom the said Jacob Barnes
