This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day of November in this year one thousand eight hundred and forty three by and between Robert Rivel of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the other part each of whom resides in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia This Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars paid to the said Robert Rivel by the above named Jacob Barnes, and before sealing and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Rivel and also before bargain bargain and sell unto him the said Jacob Barnes as certain parcel or lot of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton the same being substantially the same land which was devised to the said Robert Rivel by Henry Rivel dec'd in and by his last will and testament, whichs devise of said land had been attested by Commissioners to the different legacies of said deceased the attestation to the said Robert Rivel containing about nineteen acres the precise number of acres of the land thus sold as aforesaid as well as the homestead of the said will appear by referring to the report &c of said Commissioners for him the said Jacob Barnes. It is now and to hold the said parcel of land unto the aforesaid named the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever: with all the right title interest and estate to the said land belonging or appertaining to the said Jacob Barnes, his heirs and assigns forever: and he the said Robert Rivel with do hereby warrant and forever hereafter defend the right in and to the above described parcel of land in fee simple to him the said Jacob Barnes against himself his heirs and assigns and also against all and every person or persons whatsoever force from all manner of claim or demand whatever of whom the said Jacob Barnes
