that whereas the above named Allen Beale now stands greatly indebted to

payment of which bonds was secured or intended to be secured by a bond due
in writing bearing date the 12th day of March 1863 the said bond having been
executed by the above named Allen Beale to the above named Wiles Pifer
Conveying thereby lands real and personal estate for the purpose aforesaid Now
in Consideration of the full extinguishment of the said debt which is now at the
satisfying and delivery of these presents: Now therefore at the request of the parties
