of our Lord 1862 by and between Wm Pp. Allen Beale and Nancy Beale wife  
said Beale of the first part and James Hornell of the second part all the above  
named parties reside in the County of Southampton This Indenture Witnesseth  
that whereas the above named Allen Beale now stands jointly with to  
Augustine Piper as appears by bond one of which bearing date on the 12<sup>th</sup> day  
of March 1825 the other bond bearing date the first day of February 1823 the  
payment of which bonds was secured or intended to be secured by a bond deed  
in writing bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 1825 the said deed having been  
executed by the above named Allen Beale to the above named Wm Pp  
Conveying thereby both real and personal estate for the purpose aforesaid that  
in Consideration of the full being paid of the said debt which is now at the  
satisfying and delivery of these presents: Now therefore at the request of the parties  
now respectively concerned in the discharge of the said debt: they the said Wm  
Pp Allen Beale and said Beale's wife Nancy have hereby bargained and sold  
and sold by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the above named  
James Hornell assignee of Augustine Piper to whose benefit the trust aforesaid  
was made all that tract lot or parcel of land named and described in the said  
deed of Trust which is of record in the Clerk's office for the County of Southampton  
to him the said James Hornell his heirs and assigns forever: To have and to hold  
the above described parcel of land and every part and parcel thereof with all the  
right title interest and estate which the said Wm Pp Allen Beale and  
Nancy Beale his wife or any or all of us have heretofore had in and to the  
said parcel of land described in the above named deed of Trust free from the  
Claims of any and all the above named Wm Pp Allen Beale's Nancy his  
wife their and each of their heirs and assigns and also free from the Claims  
of all and every person or persons whomsoever: Claiming under or by them or either  
of them and they the above named Wm Pp Allen Beale do give as the said deed bears  
himself and the said Allen Beale and wife Nancy Beale do give as they  
now heretofore held title to said land so each in their respective individual capacity  
as aforesaid warrant and defend the title of us and to the said tract or parcel of land
