

This Indenture made & entered into this 20 day of November 1843 between  
 Meagah Holloman of the first part Thomas Ridley of the second part and  
 Joseph Manry of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Meagah Holloman is  
 fully indebted to the said Joseph Manry in the sum of fifty five dollars by  
 land bearing date the 20 day of November 1843 and being willing and desirous  
 to have secured the payment thereof with the interest & which may accrue thereon  
 he hath agreed to convey the property herein after mentioned unto the said  
 Thomas Ridley in trust to be sold for that purpose. Now Therefore this  
 Indenture witnesseth that the said Meagah Holloman for and in Considera-  
 tion of the premises as well as for the further Consideration of the sum of  
 One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Ridley the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and Conveyed  
 and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & Convey unto the said Thomas  
 Ridley his Exec<sup>r</sup>'s admo<sup>r</sup> or assigns the following property to wit: two sows &  
 16 pigs one Cow 1 Calf / Walnut desk / walnut table & Silling Chair 2 bed  
 desks & furniture & stacks of fodder supposed to be about 2000 lbs entirely  
 Barrels of Corn: 10 bushels and to hold the aforesaid property and the increase  
 thereof unto him the said Ridley his Exec<sup>r</sup>'s admo<sup>r</sup> or assigns to the only  
 profit use and behing of him the said Ridley his Exec<sup>r</sup>'s admo<sup>r</sup> or assigns  
 forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that at any time hereafter when thereto required  
 by the said Joseph Manry his Exec<sup>r</sup>'s admo<sup>r</sup> or assigns the said Thomas Ridley  
 shall after giving reasonable publick Notice of the time place of sale set up  
 and sell at publick auction to the highest bidder for Cash the property aforesaid  
 and out of the monies arising therefrom after paying all expenses of sale allowing  
 the execution of this deed & the sale pay and discharge the debt aforesaid due  
 the said Joseph Manry and the Balance if any pay over to the said Holloman  
 But it hereby agreed that the property aforesaid shall remain in the possession  
 of the said Holloman and he receive the use & benefit thereof until the day of  
 sale In Testimony whereof the parties aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and  
 affixed their seals the 20 day of November above mentioned.
