bond bearing date the 20 day of November 1843 and being willing and desirous

Indenture Witnesseth that the said Micajah Hollerman for and in Consideration

and by these presents does grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Thomas

dies 1 furniture 1 black of fodder supplied to be about 2000 lbs twenty
Barrels of Corn: To have and to hold the aforesaid property and the income
thereof unto him the said Bixley his Exors admors or assigns to the only
proper use and behoof of him the said Bixley his Exors admors or assigns
forever: Upon Trust Nevertheless that at any time hereafter when the aforesaid
by the said Josiah Manny his Exors admors or assigns the said Thomas Bixley
shall after giving reasonable public Notice of the terms aforesaid of sale set up
and sell at public auction to the highest bidder for Cash the property aforesaid
and out of the monies arising therefrom after paying all expenses & costs attending

the said Josiah Manny and the Balance if any pay over to the said Hollerman
