The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above Bond Samuel B. Baines is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the twenty fifth day of November 1843 to take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue in office until the first quarterly Court to be held in the said County in the year one thousand eight hundred & forty five; If therefore the said Samuel B. Baines shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the taxes imposed by Law and arrears of taxes due in the said County of Southampton and shall truly and faithfully collect account and pay the militia fines imposed by Law and arrears of militia fines due in the said County of Southampton then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
