Know all men by these presents that we Samuel B. Hines James D. Mansfield William
Parke Joseph Parker Howell Atkins James E. Pease Jesse Parker Robert Pickers Clement Pickers
James Magist Seth M. Newsum are held and jointly bound unto the Commonwealth of
Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty thousand dollars for the payment whereof we
and every to be made our bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors
and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals
and dated this 16th day of December 1843

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above Bound Samuel B. Hines
is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by & Commission from
the Governor: under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the twenty fifth day of November
1843 to take effect from the expiration of the Term of the present Sheriff and to continue
in office until the first quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the year One
thousand eight hundred and forty four: If therefore the said Samuel B. Hines shall well
and truly Collect all taxes and poor rates and account for and pay the same in such
manner as is by Law directed and also all fines forfeitures and amercements accruing to
becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and
pay the same to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the
Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public sale and
shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said office of Sheriff during his
continuance therein: Then the above obligation is to be void and else to remain in full force and virtue
signed sealed and acknowledged
