Turner, trustee of the first part Williams Clark of the second part and Joshua Clark of the third part witness the said Williams Clark on the 15th day of Septemr in the year of our Lord 1843 in order to the payment of the sum of Five hundred dollars to the said Joshua Clark as by indenture of trust of that date convey unto the said John S. Turner his heirs & executors following perfectly to make wherein Williams Clark doth give upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and whereas since the making and delivery of the said act of trust the said Williams Clark hath fully satisfied and paid the said sum of Five hundred dollars with the legal interest and cost by sale made by the said trustee of two of the before named Negroes Negro woman Martha and Negro man Tom Long for the sum of his hundred & Ninety two dollars thereby leaving which the said trustees their authority acknowledge to have sold the aforesaid Williams Clark for the Consecration of one act to be in hand paid by the said Williams Clark to the said John S. Turner; at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John S. Turner with the act and approbation of the said Joshua Clark signified by his being party to these presents and the said Joshua Clark have granted, bargained and sold remised released and confirmed unto the said presents their great desire and will herein release and confirm unto the said Williams Clark all the estates right titles interests & claims I demand both at law and in equity which the said John S. Turner and Joshua Clark have had in the Negroes aforesaid and not sold under said trust. Namely, by gifts
