This Indenture Made this 3rd day of February One thousand eight hundred and forty three between John B. Sumner, Treasurer of the first part Williams Clark of the second part and Joshua Clark of the third part witnesses the said Williams Clark on the 15th day of Sept in the year of our Lord 1843 in order to the payment of the sum of Five hundred dollars to the said Joshua Clark and by indenture of trust of that date convey unto the said John B. Sumner his heirs and assigns the following property to wit: certain Homesteads by King Marchoe Siler bequeathed unto the said John B. Sumner for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and released since the executing and delivery of the said deed of trust the said Williams Clark hath fully satisfied and paid the said sum of Five hundred dollars and the legal interest and out by sale made by the said trustee of two of the before named Negroes Negro woman Marchoe and Negro Man King for the sum of Six hundred and thirty two dollars thereby bequeathed unto the said Joshua Clark and the said Joshua Clark acknowledge that the said indenture Marchoe Siler for the consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Williams Clark to the said John B. Sumner; at and after the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John B. Sumner with the assent and approbation of the said Joshua Clark signified by his being party to these presents and the said Joshua Clark have granted bargained and sold remised released and confirmed unto the said presents with good bargain and sale certain release and confirm unto the said Williams Clark all the estate right title interest claim demand debt of Law and in equity which the said John B. Sumner and Joshua Clark then held in the Negroes which they conveyed and not sold unto said deed thereby by this
