This Indenture made the 12th day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty three between Alfred Bolle and Margaret Bolle his wife of the one part and Elizabeth Darden of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Alfred Bolle & Margaret his wife in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Darden at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do hereby present unto the Bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth Darden or Certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and containing fifty acres more or less and Bounded by the Lands of Elizabeth Darden and the heirs of Thomas Parke dead with all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever to the said Elizabeth Darden and the heirs and assigns and reservations remainderd yearly and other rents fines and other profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said fifty acres of Land with the tenements hereto in like kind to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Elizabeth Darden his heirs and assigns forever and the said Alfred Bolle and Margaret his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Elizabeth Darden his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said Alfred Bolle & Margaret his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other persons or persons whatsoever shall now and do now and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof the said Alfred Bolle & Margaret his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
