This Indenture made and entered into on this 31st day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty three between Belinda Wicks of Clinton County State of Ohio of the one part and John Hargrave of Southampton County State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Belinda Wicks for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and sixteen dollars say said John Hargrave is William Henry Wicks and to Sally Wicks the Mother of said Belinda Wicks. On the 12th day of April 1836 as well appear hereinafter to their deed to said John Hargrave of that date the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged she the said Belinda Wicks hath granted conveyed and sold and by these presents doth grant convey and sell unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever all that right title interest Claim or demand of in and to one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of St. Lukes Containing by estimation One hundred and sixty acres be the same more or less being the tract of land of which the Negro Wicks the father of said Belinda Wicks was possessed and bounded by the lands of said John Hargrave Robert P. Thomas and others to have and to hold all the right title interest Claim or demand of her the said Belinda Wicks of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging or in wise appertaining unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever to and for the use purposes and behoof of him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever and the said Belinda Wicks for herself her heirs Executors and assigns in consideration of the said sum of five hundred and sixteen paid as aforesaid doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said John Hargrave his heirs Executors assigns and assigns that she will by these presents warrant and forever all her said right title interest Claim or demand of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises against the Claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
