This Indenture made and entered into on this 3rd day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty three between Selinda Neale of Clinton County state of Ohio of the one part and John Hargrove of Southampton County state of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Selinda Neale for and in Consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars by said John Hargrove to Selinda Neale and to Sally Neale (the mother of said Selinda Neale) on the 17th day of April 1836 as well appear before me and to their deed to said John Hargrove of that date the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to R. Howell, Esq. the said Selinda Neale hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents dated Sept 1st 1843 doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said John Hargrove his heirs and assigns forever all her right title interest claim or demand of me and to the certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of St. Lukes containing by estimation One hundred and forty acres in the same more or less being the tract of land of which the factor of said Selinda Neale did profess and remeant by the lands of said John Hargrove (John T. Barnes and others to have and to hold all the right title interest claim or demand of her the said Selinda Neale of me and to the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances there belonging or in wise appertaining unto him the said John Hargrove his heirs and assigns forever to me for the sum of fifteen and sixpence per annum the said John Hargrove his heirs and assigns forever and the said Selinda Neale for herself her heirs executors and administrators in Consideration of the said sum of six hundred dollars paid as aforesaid doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Hargrove his heirs executors administrators and assigns that she will by these presents warrant and forever all her said right title interest claim or demand of me and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
