Howell trustee at and before the handing delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas B. Howell trustee with the affix and approbation of the said Benjamin Phillips signed by his living family to these presents and the said Benjamin Phillips having granted foregoing and both remised released and confirmed and by these presents granted foregoing debt release release and confirm unto the said George Whitefield all the ninth title interest @ claim and demand both at law and in equity whereto the said Thomas B. Howell trustee Benjamin Phillips have or hold in the land above aforesaid to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said George
