This Indenture made this thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one Between Mary Barnett of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and Jethro M. Barnes of the County of Hartford State of North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary Barnett for and in Consideration of the sum of Two thousand four hundred and sixty five dollars lawful money of Virginia to her say the said Jethro M. Barnes in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Mary Barnett & the County acknowledge hath granted conveyed and sold and by these presents hath granted conveyed sell and convey unto the said Jethro M. Barnes his heirs and executors administrators and assigns forever one undivided moiety of a certain tract or parcel of land containing nine hundred and eighty four acres less the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid and known by the name of the Blount place and bounded on the west by Cannon's Creek on the South by swamp and the lands of David Smith Miles Cook Henry Sumsted and others who the boundaries well more fully appear by reference to a deed executed by the heirs of Richard Blount dec'd to the said Mary Barnett bearing date one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine To have and to hold the said undivided moiety or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Jethro M. Barnes his heirs executors administrators and assigns to the only purpose and behoof of the said Jethro M. Barnes his heirs and assigns forever: and the said Mary Barnett for herself her heirs executors administrators and assigns hath covenanted and agrees to and with the said Jethro M. Barnes his heirs and assigns that she the said Mary Barnett and her heirs the said undivided moiety or parcel of land with its appurtenances: unto him the said Jethro M. Barnes his heirs and assigns against her the Mary Barnett and her heirs and against all persons whomsoever: shall and will by these presents forever warrant and defend the said Whitfield witnesses of this said Mary Barnett hath hereunto set her hand and affix her seal this day and year above written
