acknowledged by the said Spottley Williams his grantee hereinafter sold

also release and confirm to the said L^t H^l Mason and G^l H^l Newson all the

Executors Administrators as herby further Commanded agrees to with the said L^t H^l
Mason and G^l H^l Newson their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever in
manners and from following to wit that the said Spottley Williams his heirs Executors
and Administrators the aforesaid slaves with the future increase of the females thereof
and all the other property hereby conveyed unto the said L^t H^l Mason & G^l H^l Newson
their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns against the claims & demands of all
persons shall and will answer and forever defend day these presents: Alford Israel
Knewles that the said L^t H^l Mason and G^l H^l Newson their heirs Executors
and Administrators the said Spottley Williams to remain in quiet and peaceful possession
of the aforesaid slaves and other property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof
to his own use until the first day of January next and then upon further notice shall
the possession of them shall and will be done for that time as they either of them may
think proper or the said I^r George Drennan their Executors Administrators & assigns shall require
that the aforesaid slaves and the increase of the females thereof and all the other property
hereby conveyed or make part of the hereby granted property as the master or trustees shall
think sufficient for the purpose and shall sell to the highest bidder for cash at public
auction after having first the time and place at their own discretion and giving ten days
Notice thereof and out of the monies arising from such sale shall after satisfying the
