This Indenture made and entered into this fifteenth day of December 1813 between Arthur C. Maggill of the first part of Southampton County and Abraham Beasdale of the second part of Bedford County N. C. and Daniel A. Hunt of the third part of Southampton County whereof the said Beasdale Hunt is leaving for the sum of three hundred and fifty eight dollars & 1/100 with interest from September 1813 due to the said Maggill to Joshua Ferguson who is not indebted and acknowledged from the sum of one dollar payable to be for the sum of one dollar and one cent not indebted and the said Arthur C. Maggill being desirous to save the said Beasdale and Hunt from the sum of one dollar and one cent by reason of these several surrenders to the said Indenture witnesses that for and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by Beasdale the receipt of which is so hereby acknowledged the said Beasdale & Maggill have given granted conveyed and sold unto him the said Beasdale the following property to wit: viz one tract or parcel of land containing sixty six and 2/3 acres adjoining the lands of Daniel Beasdale the son of Mary J. Maggill & others also my interest it being two shares in the same land of Mary J. Maggill which will be about seventy acres be the same more or less: to have and to hold unto him the said Beasdale and his heirs forever: After Teste Notwithstanding that the said Beasdale & Maggill is in possession of the aforesaid property until required to be sold by Beasdale & Hunt whereupon the said Beasdale & Hunt shall after advertising the same and place of sale proceed to sell all the property named or intended to be conveyed in the indenture and first pay the said Beasdale the sum of one dollar and one cent and the balance if any pay over to the said Beasdale & Maggill: as Witness we set our hands and seals this day and date first before written
