This Indenture made this 21st day of June in the year of our Lord 1843 between Thurgess Lain master of the first part Joseph Jackson the seller of the second part and A. L. H. Burgess the Consider of the third part witnesses the said Joseph Jackson on the 2nd day of June in the year of our Lord 1843 in view to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty four hundred dollars to the said A. L. H. Burgess did by indenture of trust of that date convey to the said A. L. H. Burgess his heirs executors &c the following property to wit Land slaves & Chattels and his interest in the slaves of Mrs Weston upon trust for the use and purpose in the said indenture mentioned: And whereas since the executing and delivery of the said deed of trust the said A. L. H. Burgess has departed this mortal life and the said A. L. H. Burgess becomes the purchaser of a tract of land of 200 acres more or less also his interest in the slaves & Chattels estate of the dowry of Mrs Weston & his interest 200 acres of land in right of said purchase wife for the sum of 331 dollars and 60/100 Cents which the said A. L. H. Burgess hath bequeathed to his heirs Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for the Consideration aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Joseph Jackson to the said Thurgess Lain at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thurgess Lain have granted bargained and sold remised and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell remised and confirm unto the said A. L. H. Burgess all the estate right title interest claim and demand both at law and in equity which the said Thurgess Lain now hold in the land and slaves above described To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land together with the several slaves and their increase of the hands of the dowry of Mrs Weston to the only persons and their heirs of him the said A. L. H. Burgess his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever: and the said Thurgess Lain for himself his heirs executors and assigns unto the said A. L. H. Burgess his heirs executors administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same well accordeth by the said Joseph Jackson by the deed of trust above recited do warrant and deliver to the said A. L. H. Burgess against the Claim or Claims of him the said Thurgess Lain and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them (Notwithstanding) shews to these presents hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the second year first above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of
