This Indenture made and entered into on this 1st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Daniel Fields of the first part and William D. Blanks of the second part: Hammonton P. Pojo: B. Ed. S. P. Paper Merchant D. Barnham Missis Pojo John E. Beale and Henry Penrose of the third part; all of them above named of the County of Southampton and state of New Jersey: This Indenture
Witnesseth that whereas the said Daniel Pojo is fully indebted to the said Hammonton P. Pojo by bond or note with this Indenture for one hundred and five Dollars and
one other sum of money due with this indenture for forty dollars due the twenty first
day of December next; also the said Daniel Fields is fully indebted to the said D. Blanks
J. H. P. Pojo by bond bearing date with this indenture for thirty nine dollars and 6/100
also to the said Merchant D. Barnham by bond due the first day of January 1843 for
thirty two dollars also to the said Hammonton P. Pojo by bond due the 1st day of January 1843
bearing date the 26th Decr 1842 for forty seven dollars and fifty Cents also to the said
John E. Beale as security for the said Daniel Fields by bond due to John E. Beale
bearing date the 18th day of December 1842 for forty two dollars and 40/100 and also to the
said Henry Penrose by bond bearing date the 6th Decr 1843 for fourteen dollars
and 25/100 and by one other for nine dollars 10/100 due the 30th October 1843 and
the said Daniel Fields being willing and desirous to release the above named debts
entirely and cut: Now This Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar to the said Daniel Fields by the said William D. Blanks is here on hand
paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said Daniel Fields hath given granted bargained sold and confirmed
and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said William D. Blanks
his heirs and assigns forever his entire interest in the estate of John Howard and here
in down by the late Sarah Pojo wife of Hammonton P. Pojo also his entire interest in the estate
of Samuel B. Howard and also three beds and furniture twelve chairs two tables one
Buffet and all other house hold and kitchen furniture one hundred twenty barrels of corn
two thousand pounds of bacon one thousand pounds pork: To have and to hold the before
mentioned interest of the said buildings and property described unto him the said William D.
Blanks his heirs and assigns forever (except trust) and Knighthood if the said Daniel Fields
shall pay all of the before mentioned debts entailed upon him this indenture will be void
otherwise to remain in full force: and the said William D. Blanks at the request of
either party after giving ten days notice shall at public auction for cash the last before
interest in the before mentioned interest at some suitable place and at his place of
residence the aforesaid property and out of the proceeds first pay the last which
may exceed them pay the debts due Hammonton P. Pojo and the balance after
to this payment of the remaining debt proportionately; if there should
not be sufficient to pay them all the debts whereof we have herein
set one hundred and eight or less than the day and year first
