This Indenture made the sixth day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty four between Jacob B. Bryant and Martha Ann
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
John Wells of said County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said
Jacob B. Bryant and Martha Ann his wife in consideration of the sum of fifty
dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Wells at the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargain
sold and conveyed these presents as bargain and sell unto the said John Wells his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of
Southampton on the North side of Rottmar river and bounded as follows begin
ning in the main river of said river a little below the main river place and
running thence a line of marked trees to a poplar grove a corner in John Wells
line for Jacob B. Bryant and Bryant Bryants Ed thence up John Wells line
to Captain Simmons line and up said Simmons line along the meadow of bush
to a black gum a corner in said Simmons line for Jacob B. Bryant and
Bryant Bryants Ed thence a line of marked trees to the main river of said river
and thence down the main river of the river to the beginning containing one hundred
and fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances
whosoever thence belonging in any way appertaining; To have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the said premises unto
the said Bryant or intended to be bargain and sold and every part and parcel
thereof with every of their right heirs and appurtenances unto the said John
Wells his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jacob B. Bryant and Martha
Ann his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land
with all and singular the premises and appurtenances having before mentioned
the said John Wells his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of the
said Jacob B. Bryant and Martha Ann his wife their heirs and assigns and
every person or persons whatsoever shall meet and do now and in the future
