Third Indenture made the sixth day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty four between Jacob D. Bryant and Martha
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
John Little of said County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said
Jacob D. Bryant and Martha his wife in consideration of the sum of Fifty
dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Little at the sealing and delivery

of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and
sold and doth sell these presents as bargained and sold unto the said John Little his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County
of Southampton on the North side of Notchway river and bounded as follows begin-
ning in the main river of said river a little below the indentured place and
running thence as line of Martha's line to a point where a corner in John Little's
line for Jacob D. Bryant and Bailey Bryant is there at John Little's line to
the corner Simmons line and so back Simmons line along the meadow of which
is a black grist or corner in said Simmons line for Jacob D. Bryant and
Bailey Bryant last thence a line of Martha's line to the main river of said
and thence down the main river of the river to the beginning containing one hundred
and fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances
whatsoever thereunto belonging in any way appertaining; to have and to let
the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises herein
before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel
thereof with every of their rights, members and appurtenances unto the said John
Little his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Jacob D. Bryant and Martha
his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land
with all and singular the premises and appurtenances herein before mentioned in
the said John Little his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of whom
ever person or persons whatsoever shall well and as a witness and forever defit
by these presents; In witness whereof the said Jacob D. Bryant and Martha
his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above
