Summers and wife Leary for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars Current Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Denny Bittle at & before the creating and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents hath given granted bargained sell and confirm unto him the said Denny Bittle his heirs and assigns forever three entire interest in the tract or parcel of land hereunto bequeathed to Mary Ann Bittle by the late Joseph Bessie lying and being in the County aforesaid together with all the right title interest claim and demand of us and to the above tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances hereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold
