Eight hundred and forty four between Richard B. Timmons and wife Lucy of the one part  
and Drury Beale of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of  
Virginia. Whereas that the said Richard B. Timmons and wife Lucy for and in consider-  
ation of the sum of Fifty dollars Current Money of this Commonwealth is then in  
hand paid by the said Drury Beale at or before the making and delivery of these  
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and  
conveyed and by these presents doth grant Drury Beale all Conquins unto him the  
said Drury Beale his heirs and assigns forever three entire interest in the tract  
of land hereunder described to Mary Ann Beale by the late Joseph Beale living  
and being in the County aforesaid together with all the right title interest claim  
or demands of or in the above tract of land and premises made its  
appearance thereunto belonging in every way appertaining. We have and to hold
