Breach & Smith are the secures and the debt due to the said Wm. Abenethy admr. as aforesaid together with all the interest which may have accrued thereon & finally pay the bond due to the said Mason of one hundred & twenty nine dollars & 78 Cents together with the interest on the same: to which there is no security, I shoud think be any balance remaining in the hands of the said Chambliss after paying the above debts interest pay the same over to the said Bond or his order but should the said Bond pay the said debts together with all the interest due thereon & the Cost of recording this act before a sale of said property is made then this Instrument is to be void and testimony whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands & seals the day & year first herein written
