Parents & from the said Lucy Elizy Estey fully & Carter the tract of land purchased
of John Dornell containing 255 acres or thereabouts as per the Deeds
of Wm & Jones Lathers & the increase of Negroes if any. We have and to
hold the above named property hereby Conveyed unto the said James D.
Westbrook his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the one
prosperous & honest Conveyed unto the said James D Westbrook his
heirs Executors and administrators of the said Henry Harrison for himself his heirs Executors and
administrators & hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said James
D Westbrook his heirs &c in manner and form following that is to say
that the said Henry Harrison his heirs Executors and administrators the
aforesaid property hereby Conveyed unto the said James D Westbrook his
heirs Executors and administrators against all persons whatsoever shall
and will warrant and forever defend by these presents upon such Notes
themselves that the said James D Westbrook his heirs Executors &c shall permit
the said Henry Harrison to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the
above named tract of land also the following slaves from Charles Charlotte
& those children Henry Estey & Ben Lucy Elizy fully & Carter hereby
Conveyed and take the property thereof to his own use until default be
Made in the payment of the sum of Four hundred and four dollars
and Ninety Cents also on the payment of the bond due to Joseph S. Blaund
for four hundred and Twenty five dollars or thereabouts to which the said
John Jay stands bound as security which bond will now fully appear
either in the whole or in part and then upon this further trust so soon after
the happening of such default of payment or the said John Jay his heirs
Executors or administrators shall request sell the aforesaid tract of land together
with the above named slaves herein Conveyed or to make thereof as shall be
sufficient to pay off the above named debt of Four hundred and four
dollars and Ninety Cents also the bond due to Joseph S. Blaund for about four
hundred and twenty five dollars to which the said John Jay is bound as
security to the highest bidder for ready Money at public auction after having
given the time and place of sale at their own discretion and given at least
twenty days Notice thereof and out of the Money arising from such sale
shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other Expenses attending
such sale pay to the said John Jay his heirs Executors or administrators
the said sum of Four hundred and four dollars Ninety Cents with interest
thereon which may have lawfully accrued also the bond due to Joseph S.
