his heirs and assigns all the said Thomas Harrow lands consisting of the

acres making together one hundred and thirty five acres more or less and
bounded by the lines of fifty acres the Newhouse and others: also the
following personal property to wit: one Negro woman Narcissus and her Child
Pebba one half of Negro Tom Lewis two horses seven head of cattle eleven
sheep sixteen hogs one each and all of their necessary furniture bedding utensils
and all other house hold and kitchen furniture growing utensils
and Crops of Corn greater part to be horses and to take the aforesaid
tract of land with all their necessary remains greatly and other not
