(being the penal sum of said bond) where with it is the will of the said S. M.
Bailey to release the said Joseph Pirtlow against all loss or damage that he may
be liable to sustain as damages as aforesaid Now this Indenture further
Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the promises as well as for the further
Consideration of one action to the said Bailey by the said John B. Cabanis in hand
paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged by the said Bailey has granted bargained and sold and by
these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto John B. Cabanis
his heirs and assigns forever the following slaves to wit Vendela & two children
Martha & Margaret & Negro man Billy & his as the property of the said

intended to be conveyed to him the said John B. Cabanis his heirs & assigns
