Eighteen hundred and twenty between Bragman joyner and Jacob
Joyner of the one part and Amos Joyner of the other part witnesseth
That the said Bragman Joyner & Jacob Joyner for and in consideration
of two Dollars Current Money to them in hand paid by the said Amos
Joyner have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and
sell unto the said Amos Joyner all of their right title and no and to the
remainder in a certain parcel of land being the one third part of the tract
left by Lewis Joyner at his death & assigned to his widow Sally Joyner
as her legal owner in the lands left by the said Lewis Joyner the said
said Bragman Joyner & Jacob Joyner being two of the heirs or others
said lands estate next of kin by virtue of the Laws of descente past
and descent at the death of the said Sally Joyner to have and to
hold the said remainder with every other right I entituled in the said
doctors lands which will to the said Bragman & Jacob Joyner descent
unto him the said Amos Joyner & his heirs forever In Testimony whereof the
