This Indenture made this 17 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three between James Magee of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and Clements Rockwell of the same County and State of the second part Witness of a deed of trust executed to the said James Magee as trustee by Benjamin Brown leaving date this 17 day of May 1843 and entered in the County Court of Southampton State of Virginia for the benefit of Clements Rockwell which said deed fully appears by reference to said deed the said James Magee trustee pursuant to order made from the parties the said Brown and Rockwell after due advertisement according to the conditions of the said deed of trust said deed all the right title interest or claim in and to a certain tract of land conveyed in said deed wherein said Brown which said deed contains one hundred and twenty acres more or less bounded by the lands of George (Mills) Blackwell Jordan Sarah Black & others all of which said be seen by referring to Book Brown deed all which will appear by reference to said deed in trust to be put up at public sale to the highest bidder on the 17 day of Dec^r next up on the premises at which time and place the said Clements Rockwell became the highest and last bidder at the sum of Three hundred dollars for the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging Now this Indenture (Witnesseth) that the said James Magee (trustee) for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Clements Rockwell at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Magee (trustee) with his hand and seal also in witness whereof and confirm unto him the said Clements Rockwell his heirs and assigns forever all the aforesaid tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less (aforesaid) with the appurtenances and tenements thereto belonging with all right title interest claim or demand for unto the said tract or parcel of land with all the hundredments and emoluments to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold to him the said Clements Rockwell his heirs and assigns forever in as full amount as Monies as the said trustee is empowered by virtue of his trust aforesaid and no further nor otherwise whereof the said James Magee sets his hand and seal this day and year first above written signed sealed acknowledged and delivered in presence of
