This Indenture Made this 30<sup>th</sup> day, of December in the year of  
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty, three between Clement  
 Rochelle of the one part and Charles E. Knight of the second part all  
 of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia Witnesseth that  
 the said Clement Rochelle for and in consideration of the sum of  
 Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Charles E.  
 Knight at and before the creating and delivery of these presents the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold  
 and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell and deliver unto the  
 said Charles E. Knight his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel  
 of land lying and being in the lower district of St Lukes parish  
 in the County of Southampton lately owned by Benjamin Burns  
 and bounded by the lands of Josiah Vicko Richard Jordan Lacey Vicko  
 and others all of which will be seen by referring to Benja Burns deed  
 &c said to contain one hundred and twenty acres more or less (which  
 said land was purchased by said Rochelle in the 19<sup>th</sup> inst at a tract  
 sale of said Burns property) and released to him the said Rochelle by  
 James Magr (deceased) together with all the singular houses gardens  
 tenements endowments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the  
 same belonging or in any wise appertaining and every part and parcel  
 thereof to have and to hold the said land with the tenements houses  
 and all and singular other the premises having before mentioned  
 or intended to be bargain and sold and every part and parcel  
 thereof unto the said Charles E. Knight his heirs and assigns forever  
 free from the claims of him the said Clement Rochelle or his heirs  
 and of all and every person or persons whatever claiming under or  
 through him shall well and as warrant and defend the same by  
 these presents so far only as was Benjamin Burns entered and lile as  
 conveyed to the said Rochelle by the said James Magr deceased by  
 virtue of said deed and no further And Witnesseth that the said  
 Clement Rochelle hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and
