Indenture Witnesseth that for an consideration of the premises and its full
and entire satisfaction of my actio to the said Johnn Spivey the debtor in hand paid by
himself at and before the bearing and delivery of these presents the sum of
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Johnn Spivey hath given
granted bargained and sold I by these presents unto you grant bargains and
sell to the said Phagan Lewis his heirs and assigns forever all my interest
in Thirty acres of land also three lots & furniture of Dogen chair one
spinning wheel three chairs one writing desk two tables one sofa one chd you
one chd L width one ft. and iron lamp & shovel one case I bottle myself &
one box one eight head of hogs Crop of corn I gather I comforter bed &
lawn and to hold the aforesaid Ramet property unto the Phagan Lewis his
heirs & assigns forever to the only use and behoof of him that
Phagan Lewis his heirs & assigns forever and the said Johnn
Spivey for himself his heirs & assigns assigns the said Covenants promise and

assigns forever in manner & form following that is to say that the Johnn
