sum of Thirty six dollars and Eighty Cents of Lawful Money of Virginia to  
them in hand paid by the said Marks J. Poste at or before the sealing and  
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
granted bargained sold and confirmed and given by these presents unto grand  
Language bill and confirmed unto him the said Marks J. Poste his heirs and  
assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances  
situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton Containing  
by late survey Twenty acres and bounded by the lands of Stevey Standard  
the said Marks J. Poste and Bartholomew J. Busham together with all the right  
title interest claims or demands of me and to the above described tract or parcel  
of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise  
appertaining to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and  
premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him  
the said Marks J. Poste his heirs and assigns forever to use for the purpose  
use and behoof of him the said Marks J. Poste his heirs and assigns forever  
and the said Bartholomew J. Busham and wife Martha Jane for themselves their  
heirs Executrix and Administratrix with herby covenant and agree to and with  
the said Marks J. Poste his heirs Executrix Administratrix and assigns that they  
will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid  
said tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against  
the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever who or what  
whereof the said Bartholomew J. Busham and wife Martha Jane shall have need
