 to a certain deed of trust executed by Robt. Murrell for the benefit of Joseph
 I. Colaba all of the County of Southampton of the first part and Joseph I.
 Colaba of the County of said other part Witnesseth that for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars of lawful Money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid by the said Joseph I. Colaba on or before the bearing
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said William B. Jones trustee aforesaid to the said William B.
 Jones trustee as aforesaid HAVE sold at public auction to the highest
 bidder agreeable to the provisions made in said deed of Trust or certain tract
 or parcel of land and by these presents to the said William B. Jones trustee
 as aforesaid. he has granted bargain and sell aliened conveyed and confirmed and
 by these presents doth bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said
 Joseph I. Colaba his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land
 whereas the said Robt. Murrell then residing together with all the appurtenances
 lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation one
 hundred and the same more or less and bounded as follows by the land
 of Nathan N. Thomas and the land belonging to the estate of J. Murrell
 of Bruns Wells To HAVE and to hold the said bargain and tract or parcel of
 land unto all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said
 William B. Jones trustee as aforesaid to the very proper use and behoof of
